

Educational System

The educational system in the Republic of Croatia includes:

- > pre-school education,
- basic education (compulsory and free of charge for all children aged seven to fifteen),
- > secondary education and
- > tertiary education.



Education in Croatia at all levels (basic, secondary and tertiary education) is under the competence of the Ministry of Science, Education and Sports.



Pre-school Education

- Pre-school education (institutional) takes place from the time when the child is one year old and lasts until he or she is six or seven years old.
- It takes place in nurseries, kindergartens and the so-called 'pre-school' (a form of preparation for elementary school).



- Pre-school education includes children of the members of national minorities, such as Italians, Hungarians, Czechs, Serbs, Germans, Austrians and members of the Roma community.
- The regular programmes also include children with special needs, children with minor disabilities, as well as gifted children, for whom special educational and developmental programmes are being developed.



Compulsory Education

- Basic and compulsory education (elementary school) provides a wide all-round education lasting eight years, which has developed from education systems that used to last 4, 5, 6, or 7 years.
- Basic education is organised in two 4-yearlong stages: one-teacher education (only one teacher does all the teaching) and subject teaching (the teaching is done by several teachers, their number depending on the number of subjects).

Secondary Education

- · Upper secondary education is divided into:
- > 4-year general education (gymnasia);
- > 4-year vocational education (technical and other vocational schools);
- > 4-year art education;
- 3-year vocational schools and completed profession schools
- schools for occupations which require lower education qualification;
- > training.



Universities

- Among Croatian academic institutions, Universities take the most important place. These starting points for each young intellectual are located in four biggest Croatian cities:
 - Osijek, Rijeka, Split and Zagreb.
- In smaller cities, there are colleges, which educate students for specific occupations that are of interest for the local economy.



About our school

 In 1887 school was established as: Mješovita industrijsko - obrtnička škola Karlovac (Industry and Trade Vocational School Karlovac)



• In our school were 11 traditional classrooms, school library, rooms director, counselor room, staff room, the secretariat, cabinet head of practical training, cabinet for computer, kitchen, hair lab, bakery lab, photography lab and nail lab, and space for exercise and practical training (bricklayer, ceramics - paver, painter).


